In conjunction with the Indiana Historical Society's *Hoosiers in Hollywood* exhibit on display in the Rapp Family Gallery, the IHS will open *A Century of Black Film*, an exhibition that celebrates the contributions of African Americans to the film industry. On loan from The Separate Cinema Archive, the film posters chronicle a century long journey of this country's black film stars, including Hoosiers such as Fred Williamson (*Hammer*) and William Marshall (*Blacula*), among others.

Since 1830, the Indiana Historical Society has been Indiana's Storyteller™, connecting people to the past by collecting, preserving, interpreting and disseminating Indiana history. The independent, nonprofit organization also sponsors teacher workshops; provides youth, adult and family programming, and maintains one of the largest collections of material on the history of Indiana and the Old Northwest.
